We leveraged on our experience and performance of ArmaFlex elastomeric-based cellular insulation for reliable condensation control and added a tough skin to provide protection against the elements of outdoor applications, especially in tropical climate conditions," explains Xinyan Pay, APAC Product Manager, Armacell.

This product achieves both the RoHS and REACH certification according to European Union directive on the limitation of hazardous ingredients and shows no obvious ageing phenomenon in the accelerated test of 400 hours under a xenon lamp.

98 percent of all insulation failures are due to moisture and one of Armacell's systems comprised of ArmaFlex Shield CX, ArmaFlex Class 0 and ArmaFlex 520 adhesive complemented with ArmaFix® pipe hangers, when properly installed can help to reduce this risk.
